REMINDER: National Night Out - Tuesday August 1st, 2017 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

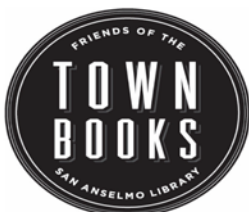
Mark your calendars – National Night Out is Tuesday, August 1st and Central Marin Police Authority is looking forward to their second year of fun and conversation with members of our communities.
