A petition was received from residents in the vicinity of Waverley Road, to macadamize roadway of Bolinas Ave. & Waverley Road to Oak Ave. Referred to Street Committee.

Upon motion of Trustee Marple seconded by Trustee Gagan, the thirty-five day payment of 25% of Sections A and C, were ordered paid by a warrant on the Treasurer, amounting to \$3337.75; as \$1000.00 had been previously paid, the warrant was ordered drawn for \$2337.75, in favor of the Marin Rock Co.

Upon motion by Trustee Gagan seconded by Trustee Whitaker a warrant for \$589.47 was ordered drawn in favor of the Marin Rock Co. in payment of the work on road in front of the R. R. Station between the new concrete bridge and the R. R. ~~crossing~~ ^{crossing} on the north ^{side} that the bill for the balance, namely \$276.94 be rejected. This bill was originally for \$866.41 but Engineer Dodge approved same for \$589.47, leaving the balance, as above mentioned, in dispute.
