

At a regular adjourned meeting held March 22, 1912, at 8:35 P.M., the following members of the Board were present,

An application was received from Earl Dougherty in the Sequoia Park Tract, asking permission to blast. Motion made by Trustee Gagan seconded by Trustee Schrader that permission be granted subject to filing of the proper bond in the sum of \$1000.00 and according to the Town Ordinance #51. Motion carried.

The Clerk was ordered to have printed the necessary amount of statements referring to the general statement of conditions of the Town and the coming Bond Election.

^{an} Ordinance providing for obtaining permit for the erection, construction, maintenance or use of any structure of building to be used as a planing mill, saw mill, etc., was presented by Trustee Gagan and given its first reading.

Motion made by Trustee Gagan seconded by Trustee Schrader that the balance of the acceptance payment of ~~\$1540~~^{\$1540.50} on Section E + F be paid the Marin Rock Co. by warrant ^{on} ~~of~~ the Treasurer. Total amount due due on the sections was ~~\$2790~~^{\$2790.50}. An advance payment of \$1250.00 had been made previously leaving the amount of ~~\$1540~~^{\$1540.50} still due. Motion carried.

The Clerk was ordered to write the Northwestern Pacific Railway Co. in regard to unsanitary conditions due to the collection of manure, etc., in front of the freight sheds on the county road. Also to write to the Misses Worn in regard to drainage on their lot on Ross Ave. which now collects pools of stagnant water. Also to write Mr. Fred Croker about filling in an old well in a vacant lot fronting on Ross Ave.

Upon motion by Trustee Gagan seconded by Trustee Whittaker the Board adjourned until the next regular meeting on April 10th.
