

*Minutes May 22<sup>nd</sup> 1912*

Regular adjourned meeting, May 22nd, 1912. The Board of Trustees met in regular adjourned monthly session, on the above date, with all of the members present as follows: Trustees Crisp, Gagan, ~~Schrader~~, Whitaker and Hund. <sup>absent Trustee Schrader</sup> This being the time fixed by the Board of Trustees for the receipt of bids for the purchase of bonds of the Town of San Anselmo, in the amount of Twenty-six thousand, six hundred and fifty Dollars (\$26,650.00), and bids therefor having been received from the San Anselmo Bank, E. H. Rollins & Sons, and J. H. Adams and Company, the same were opened in the presence of the Board and read by the Clerk. That the bid of J. H. Adams and Company, in the words and figures following, to-wit:

Gentlemen:-

For the \$26,650 SAN ANSELMO, Marin County, MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT 5% BONDS, dated May 1, 1912, denominations of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000) and Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$650), maturing One Thousand Dollars (\$1000) each year from 1913 to 1938, inclusive, and Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$650) in 1939, interest semi-annually, which were advertised for sale on May 15th, 1912, and for which no bids were received at that time, we bid par, accrued interest to date of delivery, together with a premium of Six Hundred forty-one (\$641.00) dollars.

As evidence of our good faith we enclose herewith certified check for Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00), payable to the order of the Treasurer of the Town of San Anselmo, as part payment of the purchase price of the bonds if our bid is accepted.

The above bid is made subject to the condition that the proceedings leading up to this issue are legal in every respect, according to the opinion of our attorneys, and that these bonds when and as issued shall constitute a legal and binding obligation upon said Town of San Anselmo, and that we shall be furnished with a certified copy of the proceedings leading up to the issue.

In the event the above bid is not accepted in all of its terms, said check for Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500) is to be returned to us.
