

## Minutes of April 19th, 1915

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, April 19th, 1915 at 8:00 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Atthowe, Hall, Schrader and Kemp.  
Absent, Trustee Crisp.

The minutes of the meeting of April 5th, 1915 were read and approved.

#### Liquor Applications

The application of C. E. Thomas was upon motion of Trustee Schrader, seconded by Trustee Hall, granted.

Applications for renewals of Liquor Licenses from J. D. Waterman and P. M. Autzen were upon motion duly seconded, granted.

An application for a Liquor License in connection with his restaurant was received from Emil Fischer. This was laid over for five days as provided by Ordinance.

The Clerk was directed to pro rate all licenses to the 31st of December, 1915.

#### Communications

A letter from the Sanitary Board of District No. 1 in reference to properly filling streets after making excavations for sewers was ordered filed.

A letter from the Woman's Improvement Club in reference to Cleaning up of sidewalks and lots was referred to the Marshal with instructions to report all delinquents to the Clerk.

#### Sidewalk width complaint

The complaint made by Mrs. Stenbiht at the last meeting in reference to width of sidewalk on San Francisco Boulevard was taken up and the Clerk directed to read the Ordinance governing the width of sidewalks. It being apparent that Mr. Croker had violated the Ordinance when making improvements on the above mentioned street, the Clerk was directed to notify him of the violation and instruct him to widen the street area to 36 feet.

#### Ordinances

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 107 in reference to the disposition of Manure was given a second reading, and passed and adopted by the following vote:

Ayes, Trustees Atthowe, Hall, Schrader and Kemp.  
Noes, None. Absent, Trustee Crisp.

An Ordinance regulating the Keeping and Storing of Gasoline and Oil was given a first reading.

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 39 in reference to the width of Sidewalks was given a first reading.

#### Lighting of Yolanda Court

Trustee Hall reported that the cost of installing six Electroliers in Yolanda Court would be \$404.10. The Property owners would pay \$140.00 towards this, the Gas and Electric Co. \$186.92 and the Town would have to expend the balance of \$77.18.

On motion of Trustee Schrader, seconded by Trustee Atthowe the Street Committee was directed to have the Lights installed and to see that the bill for same would come in after July 1st so as to come on the next year's budget.

#### Complaints on Sanitation

On motion of Trustee Schrader, seconded by Trustee Hall, the Clerk was directed to communicate with Dr. Kuser the County Health Officer in regard to unsanitary conditions existing outside of the Town Limits but directly affecting the people in Town, viz: A toilet maintained by Dr. Scosseria in Deer Park over the Creek and an overflowing Cess Pool just outside of the Bush Tract Limits in the Fairfax Tract.

#### Payment on Fire Alarm System

On motion of Trustee Atthowe, seconded by Trustee Hall, the final payment on the Fire Alarm System amounting to \$674.50 was ordered paid.

#### Rebate on Insurance

The Clerk was directed to write to the State Compensation Insurance Fund regarding the rebate that was coming to the Town on its expired Compensation Policy.

The matter of Insurance on the Town Employees was referred to Trustee Atthowe to look up and report back at the next meeting.

#### Yolanda Drain

A complaint was made by Mr. Autzen of Yolanda in reference to the open ditch at Yolanda where a drain had been put in. The Street committee was directed to have the matter attended to.

#### Dance Platform

The Finance Committee was directed to take charge of the


Dance Platform in the Osgood Tract and attend to the operation of same during the ensuing season.

#### Gutters and Curbs

A complaint being made that a Curb and gutter had been installed on Medway Road which did not conform at all to the line and grade, the Town Engineer was directed to frame an ordinance governing the installation of Curbs and Gutters.

#### Adjournment

On motion duly seconded, the meeting was then adjourned.
