

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, March 6th, 1916 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Absent, Trustee Schrader.

The minutes of the meeting of February 7th were read and approved.

Liquor Application

An application for transfer of Liquor License from Vonderheide and Mingst to Buckley and Co. was laid over the customary five days.

Short Ranch Sewer

A letter from Mr. G. B. Linali in reference to sewer condition on the San Francisco Boulevard was referred to the Sanitary Committee to report back at the next meeting

Tamalpais Fire Assn.

A letter from the Tamalpais Fire Association asking the cooperation of the Town of San Anselmo in an endeavor to get an appropriation from the Board of Supervisors was referred to the Clerk to answer.

Extension of Time : Marin Rock Co.

An application for an extension of thirty days in which to complete their contract for a storm sewer on Willow Avenue was granted to the Marin Rock Company, upon motion of Trustee Crisp, seconded by Trustee Hall.

Culvert on Oak Avenue

A communication was received from ~~Mr.~~ Warren P. Landon in reference to damage being done on his property on account of a culvert leading across Oak Avenue into his lot. He requested the removal of the Culvert and construction of a gutter along the road to carry off the water.

On motion of Trustee Crisp, seconded by Trustee Kemp, the Board went on record as agreeing to make the changes desired out of the next years budget, the cost not to exceed \$100.00.

Planning Commission

A communication from the City Planning Commission containing several recommendations, especially the extension of Cedar Street, was referred to the Street Committee.

Reports

A report from the Town Engineer on the Small street, opposite the entrance to Floribel Park, On the Lansdale Bridge, and on Roads and Culverts was laid over until the next meeting.

Reports were received from the Marshal, Building Inspector and Treasurer and after being read were ordered filed.

Business Licenses

An ordinance amending certain sections of the Business License ordinance was given a first reading.

Woman's Improvement Club


