

## Minutes of March 13th, 1916

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, March 13th, 1916 at 8:00 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Kemp, Crisp, Hall and Atthowe.  
Absent, Trustee Schrader.

The minutes of the meeting of March 6th were read and approved.

#### Mosquito Pools

A petition was received from residents along Willow Avenue asking relief from the mosquito breeding places along said street. The Clerk was directed to have the pools oiled at once as an emergency measure and write to the owners to abate the nuisance or the Town would have it done at their expense.

#### Electrical Inspection

A protest was received from Mr. P. Hamilton in reference to actions of the Town Electrical Inspector. Mr. Bowley explained his action satisfactorily to Board and the letter was ordered filed.

#### Transfer Liquor License

The matter of a transfer of the Liquor License held by Vonderheide and Mingst to Buckley and Company was referred to the Town Attorney, the Clerk in the meantime being instructed to grant Buckley and Company a Temporary License until the matter was settled.

#### Business Licenses

An ordinance "Repealing the License Tax imposed on all persons transacting or carrying on business as Physicians or Surgeons, also Contractors or Builders, and modifying the License Tax imposed on the Express Business", was given a second reading and adopted by the following vote:

Ayes, Trustees Kemp, Crisp, Hall and Atthowe.  
Noes, None. Absent Trustee Schrader.

#### Short Ranch Sewer

The Town Engineer was instructed to look into the feasibility of running a sewer from the Linali place on San Francisco Road to the Olema Road and thence to the Saunders Avenue Sewer.

Trustee Hall offered a Resolution ordering Plans and Specifications for the said Sewer provided it proved feasible. Said Resolution was seconded by Trustee Crisp and adopted by the following vote,

Ayes, Trustees Crisp, Hall, Kemp and Atthowe.  
Noes, None. Absent, Trustee Schrader.

#### Lansdale Bridge

Trustee Kemp offered a Resolution Ordering Plans and Specifications

for the Construction of a Concrete Bridge over the Creek at Lansdale, with the intention of forming an assessment district of the whole Town to pay for same, and moved its adoption. The motion to adopt said Resoltuion was seconded by Trustee Hall and carried by the following vote:

Ayes, Trustees Hall, Crisp, Kemp and Atthowe.  
Noes, None. Absant, Trustee Schrader.

Board of Health

An ordinance establishing a Board of Health for the Town of San Anselmo and nameing O. W. Jones, H. E. C. Feusier, Mrs. EMMA G. Foley, A. Bouick, and E. I. Crane as members of said Board was given its first reading.

Newspaper Reports

Mr. F. J. Burke and Mr. R. Leach addressed the Board in reference to scurrilous Newspaper articles which have appeared in the San Francisco dailies of late. Trustees Atthowe, Crisp and Kemp were appointed as a Committee to wait upon the Newspaper managers with a view to having the articles retracted and any future ones stopped.

On motion duly seconded, the meeting was then adjourned to Tuesday evening, March 14th, 1916 at 8 O'clock P. M.
