

## Minutes of May 1st, 1916.

The Regular Monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, May 1st, 1916 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Kemp, Burke, Perry, Schrader and Atthowe.  
Absent, None.

The minutes of the meetings of April 17th and April 21st, were read and approved.

**Petitions**

A petition was received from residents of Subdivision 1 of the Short Ranch, asking for a Fire Hydrant on San Francisco Boulevard and after being read, was referred to the Building and Fire Committee.

A petition from owners in Karlshrue Park in reference to obstruction of sidewalks by Mr. Brennfleck was referred to the Street Committee and Town Engineer.

**Liquor License Transfers.**

Applications for transfers of Liquor Licenses, Adeline Descalzi to H. W. Strudwick and Vonderheide and Mingst to Buckley & Co. were granted. Trustee Kemp voted against the transfer from Vonderheide and Mingst to Buckley and Co.

**Johnson and Dam Vs. Rauer.**

A communication from the Labor Bureau in reference to the Johnson and Dam matter was read. The Town Engineer reported that the matter had been settled subsequent to the writing of the letter.

**Short Ranch Sewers**

A letter from the Sanitary Board in reference to installation of sewers in the Short Ranch was referred to the Sanitary Committee.

Mr. G. B. Linali in a letter to the Board stated that he would run his sewer into the street unless a sewer was in the road by May 15th. The Clerk was directed to write to him and state that proceedings were under way to install this sewer but that it would take 60 to 90 days before work could be started.

**City Planning Commission**

A letter was received from the City Planning Commission asking the Board to use every endeavor towards getting a new Bridge at Lansdale. A request for transfer of the \$300.00 in the Reserve Fund to the Map Fund was upon motion of Trustee Burke, seconded by Trustee Schrader, granted.

#### Appointment of Fire Chief.

A letter from the San Anselmo Fire Department requesting the re appointment of Chas. Cartwright as Fire Chief was read and ordered filed.

#### Town Jail

A communication from the Woman's Improvement Club in reference to the condition of the Town Jail was referred to the Sanitary Committee.

#### Stand Pipe Yolanda Court.

A request for a Stand Pipe in Yolanda Court for Sprinkling purposes was referred to the Town Attorney with instructions to ascertain if the Town could not use the Hydrants for Sprinkling water.

#### Street Light at Quarry

A request for a Street Light on Vine Avenue near the Marin Rock Co.'s Quarry was referred to the Street Committee.

#### Building Ordinance

The committee on revision of the Building Ordinance tendered its report, which was read by the Clerk. A petition from several Builders and Contractors, asking that no changes be made in the Ordinance was also read.

The matter was laid over until Thursday evening, May 4th, the Clerk being directed in the meantime to notify all those interested.

#### Reports

Reports from the Marshal and Building Inspector were read and ordered filed.

#### Stagnant Pools

An Ordinance providing for the abatement of Stagnant Pools was given a first reading

#### Res. of Intention, Short Ranch Sewers

The matter of introducing a Resolution of Intention for the installation of sewers in the Short Ranch was laid over until next Thursday evening, the Clerk being directed to notify Mr. Croker that the matter would be taken up at that time. Mr. Manning was also requested to have some representative from the Sanitary Board present.
