

A Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees duly called by order of the President of the Board and by notice duly given to each member, was held on the 18th day of July, 1916 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Kemp, Burke, Perry and Atthowe.  
Absent, Trustee Schrader.

The minutes of the meeting of July 3rd, were read and approved.

#### Communications

A protest from the Health Officer in reference to violation of the Manure Ordinance and requesting the Board to pass an ordinance prohibiting the stabling of horses within the Town Limits, was referred to the Marshal.

A request for a street light on Redwood (Canyon) Road was referred to the Street Committee.

A report was received from the Electrical Inspector and after being read was ordered filed.

#### Liquor License- I. J. Hall

After discussing the matter of the liquor license applied for by Mr. I. J. Hall, and the one now held by Mr. Geo. McNeilly, Trustee Perry moved that the license of Mr. McNeilly be revoked and the sum of \$50.00, being the amount of the license from July 1st to the end of the year which was approximately the time the controversy arose, was ordered refunded to Mr. McNeilly. Said motion was seconded by Trustee Kemp and unanimously carried.

On motion of Trustee Burke, seconded by Trustee Kemp, the application of Mr. I. J. Hall for a license was granted.

#### Eucalyptus Trees- San Anselmo Avenue.

A protest from Mr. Baloun and other residents in the neighborhood of Yolanda in reference to the cutting down of the Eucalyptus trees on San Anselmo Avenue just east of Yolanda Station was heard by the Board. After considering arguments from both sides, the Board referred the matter to the City Planning Commission to report back at the next meeting.

#### Pine St. Assessment

Mr Leach representing the Hinkel Estate, requested some information in reference to the assessments on the Pine Street work and was told that the records were open in the Clerks office for him to inspect at any time.

#### Fourth of July Funds


