



### Improvement on upper roads of Bush Tract

Trustee Schrader offered a Resolution Ordering Plans and Specifications for improvement of certain streets by Macadamizing and construction of sewers and gutters therein in the upper Hill Section of the Bush Tract and moved its adoption. The motion to adopt said Resolution was seconded by Trustee Kemp and carried by the following vote:

Town Engineer H. E. C. Feusier called attention to the way the Water Meters were being installed by the Marin Water and Power Company. The Clerk was directed to write to the Water Company and have the meters placed so the tops would be on a level with the surface of the sidewalk or street wherever placed. A letter from the Attorney of the Tunstead Company in reference to a drain placed in Lot 22 of the Linda Vista Tract by the Town was referred to the Clerk to answer with instruction to inform the Tunstead Company that the drain would be removed at once.
