

Minutes of October 23rd, 1916

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, October 23rd, 1916 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Schrader, Perry and Atthowe.
Absent, Trustees Burke and Kemp.

The minutes of the meetings of October 2nd, and October 9th, 1916 were read and approved.

Proposals- Lansdale Bridge

This being the time set for the reception of bids on the new Lansdale Bridge, the Clerk was directed to open and read all bids received, whereupon the said Clerk did publicly open read and declare the following bids:

All proposals were in proper form and accompanied by a certified check or bidders bond for at least 10% of the proposal.

After consideration by the Board, upon motion of Trustee Schrader, seconded by Trustee Perry, all bids were rejected and the Clerk was directed to return the checks or bonds of all bidders.

Closing of Pine Street Crossing

Trustee Schrader thereupon offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption, to-wit:

RESOLVED, that whereas, the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo did, on the 19th day of September, 1916 pass its Resolution of Intention No. 19 to order the work to be done and improvement to be made which is hereinafter described, and whereas, notices of the passage of the said resolution were posted and published in time, form and manner as required by law, as appears from the affidavits of W. J. Dedrick and H. E. C. Feusier, on file with the Town Clerk,

AND WHEREAS, the time having expired within which objections to said work and improvement may be made, and no objection having been made, and the Board of Trustees having acquired jurisdiction to order said work to be done and improvement to be made,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo as follows:

That Pine Street from the easterly line of San Anselmo Avenue to the westerly line of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad right of way be closed up and abandoned.

The motion to adopt said Resolution was seconded by Trustee Perry and carried by the following vote:

Ayes, Trustees Perry, Schrader and Atthowe.
Noes, None. Absent, Trustees Kemp and Burke.

Buckley & Co. Transfer of License

A request for the transfer of Liquor License to their new location by Buckley & Co. was granted.

Communications

A letter from Wm. Mayer calling attention to lights out on Crescent was referred to the Marshal.


A letter from R. J. Patcha in reference to over assessment was ordered filed, there being no merit in his complaint.
