

Minutes of October 8th, 1917

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening October 8th, 1917, at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Kemp, Perry, Reeve and Taylor.
Absent, Trustee Latham.

The minutes of the meeting of October 1st, 1917 were read and approved.

Superintendent of Streets-Resignation

Mr. Feusier tendered his resignation as Superintendent of Streets which was duly read by the Clerk. Upon motion of Trustee Perry, seconded by Trustee Reeve the resignation was accepted. Thereupon it was moved and seconded that Mr. Feusier be tendered a vote of thanks for the services he had rendered the Trustees and the Town, and the same ordered recorded in the minutes.

Report of Health Officer

Dr. O. W. Jones tendered his report for the first quarter of this fiscal year which was read by the Clerk and ordered filed.

Marshal-Resignation

Town Marshal F. L. Wight then tendered his resignation as Town Marshal to take effect at once. Upon motion of Trustee Perry, seconded by Trustee Reeve, the resignation was accepted and Mr. Wight tendered a vote of thanks for his services to the Town and to the Trustees, same to be entered upon these minutes.

Reports

Trustee Perry reported that he had looked into the matter of Electric Light and Gas rates, and found that our light rates were practically the same as all other towns of the same status and had been informed by the Railroad Commission that there was little ~~of~~ chance of a reduction. In regard to Gas rates, the rates were liable to be increased rather than lowered due to the increased price of crude oil.

Trustee Perry also reported that he had interviewed the Telephone people and had succeeded in obtaining from them free service for the two phones in the Town Hall and ^{one} more which would be installed in the Marshal's home.

Town Manager Ordinance

An ordinance creating the office of Town Manager and defining the duties of such official was given a second reading and upon motion of Trustee Perry, seconded by Trustee Kemp, was passed and adopted by the following vote:

Demands

On motion of Trustee Perry, seconded by Trustee Kemp, the following demands were ordered paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer, O. W. Jones, \$30.00, Richard Leach \$25.00 and Fred L. Wight \$25.00.

Town Marshal and Supt. of Streets

Trustee Perry placed Mr. C. A. Macomber in nomination for the office of Town Marshal. There being no other nominations, on motion of Trustee Kemp, seconded by Trustee Reev, Mr. Macomber was declared appointed by the Board to the office of Town Marshal.

Thereupon Trustee Perry placed Mr. C. A. Macomber in nomination for the office of Superintendent of Streets. There being no other nominations, on motion of Trustee Kemp, seconded by Trustee Reeve, Mr. Macomber was declared appointed to the position of Superintendent of Streets.

Trustee Taylor thereupon administered the oath of office to Mr. Macomber as Town Marshal and as Superintendent of Streets.

Lansdale Bridge



Salary- Supt. of Streets

On motion of Trustee Perry seconded by Trustee Reeve, the salary of the Supt. of Streets was fixed at \$30.00 per month.
