

MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 3rd, 1919

The Regular Monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, November 3rd, 1919 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present: Trustees Perry, Michener, Kinberg, Stevenson & Taylor.  
Absent, Trustees--None.

The minutes of the meeting of October 23rd were read and approved.

COMMUNICATIONS

A letter from the State Highway Commission in reference to sending an Engineer to consult with the Board on the Road question was referred to the Street Committee.

A request for assistance in getting subscriptions for the County Reception to returned soldiers was ordered filed. ✓

A request for allowance of veteran's exemption by Arthur K. Glaser was referred to the Clerk to answer.

A letter from W. L. Chamberlain asking the Board to construct a sewer along Savannah Road was referred to Trustee Michener, with instructions to tell Mr. Chamberlain to have a petition signed, by adjacent property owners requesting the Board to order the work.

REPORTS

Reports were received, read and filed from the Marshal, Tax Collector, Manager, Superintendent of Streets, Deputy Marshal, Fire Chief, and Building Inspector.

Upon motion of Trustee Perry, seconded by Trustee Michener the Clerk was directed to cancel the Business Licenses requested by the Manager in his report, Namely Licenses Nos. 59, 87, 98, 110, 126, 73, 86, 52, 82, 85, 93, 96, 97, 102, 108, 101. a total of \$415.42.

The matter of Garbage disposal mentioned in the Marshal's report was referred to the Attorney to submit an ordinance.

CHICKEN ORDINANCE

An ordinance regulating the keeping of domestic fowls and animals within the Town Limits was given a first reading.

HUND GARAGE

The application of Geo. B. Hund to build a Corrugated Iron Garage within the Fire Limits was ordered denied.

BOND ISSUE FOR ROAD WORK, etc.

Trustee Michener introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption, to-wit:

RESOLVED AND DETERMINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo that public interest and necessity demand the acquisition and construction and completion of the following Municipal Improvements in and for said Town, the cost of which will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said Town;

- FIRST: - The construction and completion of Portland cement concrete pavement <sup>substituting</sup> on ~~San Anselmo Avenue~~, Red Hill and Ross Landing Road and San Rafael and Olema Road, <sup>San Anselmo Avenue from Bohner Avenue to Polanda, Forest Avenue from Polanda to Fausdale and Hillside Avenue from Fausdale to San Rafael and Cedar Road.</sup>
- SECOND: The construction and completion of nine (9) Portland cement concrete bridges in and for said town.

The motion to adopt said Resolution was seconded by Trustee Perry and carried by the following vote:
