The Regular Monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, February 7th, 1921 at 8 o'clock P. M.

A Letter from the Chamber of Commerce asking the Board to amend the Chicken Housing Ordinance, was referred to the Clerk to answer with instructions to have the Chamber of Commerce give more specific instructions as to the changes desired.

Reports were received, read and ordered filed from the Fire Chief and the Building Inspector.

EXCHANGE OF PROPERTY IN SEQUOIA PARK

Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Hund, the Clerk was directed to communicate with Mrs. Erminia Patrizi and inform her that the contemplated exchange of property in Sequoia Park between her and the Town had been approved and would be made by the Board.

Upon motion of Trustee Hund, seconded by Trustee Linnell, the Clerk was directed to write to Mr. Frederick Croker and request him to appear before the Board and make a report as to what has been done by the Water District.

TRANSFER OF FUNDS

Upon motion of Trustee Stephenson, seconded by Trustee Thomas the Clerk and Treasurer were directed to transfer \$823.00 from the City Planning Fund to a Special Fund to be used only for the following purposes during the ensuing year:
