


BUILDING ORDINANCE

In Re APPLICATION OF DOHERTY CO. FOR
 INCREASE OF WATER RATES.

An Order of Dismissal in the matter of the Application of the Doherty Company for an increase in water rates having been received, the Clerk was directed to file the same.

CHECK PROTECTOR

Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Stephenson the Clerk was directed to purchase a check protector at a cost not to exceed \$15.00.

STAND PIPE--BUTTERFIELD ROAD

Upon recommendation of Chief Cartwright and upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Stephenson, the Clerk was directed to write to the Water District and request them to place a Stand Pipe hydrant on or near the Butterfield Road, in addition to the three Hydrants already ordered, at a point to be designated by Chief Cartwright.

OBSTRUCTIONS IN CREEK

Upon motion of Trustee Stephenson, seconded by Trustee Thomas the Clerk was directed to write to Mr. Robt. A. Carey and inform him that unless the debris and trees that had gathered in the creek near the Cheda Building was removed within two days, that the Town would have the work done at his expense.

HIGH SCHOOL MATTERS

Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Stephenson the Clerk was directed to request the Board of Trustees of San Anselmo School District to call an informal election to ascertain the wishes of the people as to which High School District they prefer to annex themselves to.

Upon motion of Trustee Stephenson, seconded by Trustee Thomas the Clerk was directed to write to Supervisor M. Burke and request him to be guided by the wishes of the people as expressed at the above mentioned election, when the matter of annexation is brought before the Board of Supervisors.
