LANSDALE AVENUE

A petition from owners along Lansdale Avenue requesting the Board to improve that street at the expense of the Town, was read and ordered filed.

FERN AND MADRONE AVENUE

A petition from owners along Fern and Madrone Avenues in the Bush Tract, asking for the improvements of those streets was referred to

Engineer Kennedy, with instructions to meet with the petitioners and report back to the Board.

REPORTS

Reports from the Building Inspector and from Mr. F. Croker director of the Marin Municipal Water District were received, read and ordered filed.

COMMUNICATIONS

A letter from the North Bay Counties Speedway and Fair Association, in reference to a Fair to be held and from Mr. H. Gottesfeld in reference to to an assessment in Yolanda Court were read and ordered filed.

SALARY OF RECORDER

Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Stephenson, the salary of the Town Recorder was raised from \$100.00 per year to \$400.00 per year to take effect July 1st, 1921.

STREET LIGHT( Short Ranch)

Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Stephenson, the Marshal was directed to have a light installed in the Short Ranch at a point to be designated by Mr. C. J. Patton.

FINANCE COMMITTEE


