

MINUTES OF JULY 11th, 1921

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, July 11, 1921 at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present, Trustees Hund, Stephenson, Thomas and Pinkham.
Absent, Trustee Linnell.

Town Clerk Studley being absent, Trustee Thomas was appointed acting Clerk with authority to sign and issue warrants in payment of bills.

The reading of the minutes of the meeting of July 5th, 1921 was dispensed with.

ROAD PETITIONS

Petitions were received from property owners along Medway Road and also from property owners along Maple Lane, requesting the Board to proceed with improvements along those streets. Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Hund, the Marshal was directed to advise the owners in the immediate vicinity of the property affected by these petitions to join in and form a larger district and July 22nd, 1921 was set as the date for the petitioners to meet with the Town Engineer and discuss the character of work to be done.

STREET OPENINGS

Upon motion of Trustee Hund, seconded by Trustee Thomas, the Marshal was instructed to notify all parties that might contemplate opening the streets in the future for gas, sewer, water or other connections to do the work now before the new street work is installed. The Town Attorney was also instructed to draw up a new and more stringent ordinance in connection with street openings.

PAYMENTS--STREET WORK

Upon motion of Trustee Hund, seconded by Trustee Thomas, the following warrants were ordered drawn on the Treasurer: One for \$45,000. in favor of Raisch Improvement Company out of the 1920 Bond Fund, being the portion to be paid out of that fund on the County Road Job, and also one for \$559.54 in payment of estimate by the Town Engineer dated July 11, 1921 for work done by A.J. Raisch on Tunstead Avenue and Ross Avenue crossings.

COMPLAINT ABOUT WORKMEN


Complaint having been made that men employed by A.J. Raisch on the new street work were insulting women, Mr. Riasch was informed of the complaint and he stated to the Board that he would co-operate in any way to abate the nuisance.

BUTTERFIELD ROAD MATTERS

Mr. C. J. Patton addressed the Board on behalf of the Butterfield Road Improvement Club and thanked the Board for the dirt which was put on the Road. He also stated that the Club was getting up an entertainment the proceeds of which would be used to purchase a Hose Cart and hose for the protection of that district. A request that the Board provide lumber for a Board Walk along Butterfield Road, the work of installing to be done by the Club, was taken under advisement by the Board.

MINUTES OF JULY 18, 1921

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening, July 18, 1921 at 8:00 o'clock P.M.

Present, Trustees Hund, Linnell, Stephenson, Thomas and Pinkham.
Absent, " None.

The minutes of the meetings of July 5th, 1921 and July 11th, 1921 were read and approved.

RESIGNATION OF MARSHAL, etc.

Marshal J.W. Mellor tendered his written resignation as Marshal to take effect immediately. Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Hund, the resignation was accepted. Upon motion of Trustee Thomas, seconded by Trustee Hund, the office of Superintendent of Streets was declared vacant.

Trustee Thomas thereupon placed Wilmer O'Neill in nomination for the office of Marshal and Superintendent of Streets at the salary of \$140.00 per month, and no other nominations being made, upon motion of Trustee Hund, seconded by Trustee Linnell, Mr. O'Neill was unanimously appointed Town Marshal and Supt. of Streets. Mr. O'Neill having furnished a satisfactory bond was thereupon sworn in by the Clerk.
