## YOLANDA COURT JOB--BONDS

Upon motion of Trustee Hund, seconded by Trustee Stephenson the Order providing for the issuance of Street Improvement Bonds, etc. under Resolution of Intention. No. 31, passed and adopted at the meeting held on September 6th, 1921 was rescinded, whereupon Trustee Hund presented and offered a new "Order providing for the issuance of Street Improvement Bonds, prescribing the denominations of such bonds and of the interest coupons attached thereto" and directing the Clerk to advertise for bids for such bonds, and moved its adoption. The motion to adopt said order was seconded by Trustee Stephenson and carried by the following vote:
