

MINUTES OF JANUARY 3, 1922.

Monday, January 2, 1922 being a legal holiday, the Regular Monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Tuesday, January 3, 1922 at 8 o'clock P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of December 16, 1921 were read and approved.

SALE OF IMPROVEMENT BONDS (Co. Road Job)

This being the time fixed for the reception of bids for the bonds issued under the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915" on the unpaid assessments under the County Road Job as provided for in Resolution of Intention No. 29 of this Board and no bids having been received for said Bonds by the Clerk, Trustee Hund offered a Resolution ordering the Bonds delivered to the Contractor in satisfaction of the sum due said contractor upon his assessment and warrant, and moved its adoption. The motion to adopt said Resolution was seconded by Trustee Foley and carried by the following vote:

COMMUNICATIONS

A letter from Mr. H. Lazare calling attention to the street work done in front of his property on Forest Avenue was read by the Clerk. Mr. Raisch who was present agreed to put the road in proper condition, and the Clerk was directed to notify Mr. Lazare to that effect.

A letter from Mrs. O. M. Moffitt in reference to stopping up of a drain pipe on Olive Avenue was referred to the Road overseer.

REPORTS

Mr. W. M. Rutherford addressed the Board in reference to road signs and naming and numbering of streets. After discussion, the matter was laid over for further discussion and to get other prices.

Town Marshal O'neil reported on the matter of Garbage cans quoting prices that he had received. This matter was referred to the Street Committee.

PARKING ORDINANCE

The "Ordinance Regulating the use and traffic of vehicles upon the streets and other public places of the Town of San Anselmo and providing a punishment for any violation thereof", which was introduced at the meeting of December 5, 1921 was given a second reading by the Clerk and upon roll call was passed and adopted by the following vote:

The ordinance was thereupon approved by the President of the Board and numbered 166.

TEIXEIRA BLDG. San Anselmo Ave.


