





A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the

SPECIAL MEETING OF JULY 31, 1922

A Special meeting of the Board of Trustees duly called by the President of the Board by notice given to each member of the board as required by law, for the purpose of taking up the matter of changing the Marshal's Bond, the consolidation of certain funds and the issuance of a blasting permit to Mr. S. P. Brownlee, was held on Monday evening, July 31, 1922 at 8 o'clock P. M.

Present, Trustees Pinkham, Carl, Lutters, Deysher and Clark.
Absent, " None.


The minutes of the meeting of July 17, 1922 were read and approved.

Upon motion of Trustee Pinkham, seconded by Trustee Deysher, Mr. S. P. Brownlee was granted permission to blast upon the property of the Presbyterian Orphanage upon depositing with the Town Clerk a good and sufficient bond with two sureties in the sum of \$5,000. as required by the provisions of Ordinance No. 51.

Upon motion of Trustee Deysher, seconded by Trustee Carl, the bond of the Town Marshall was increased from \$5,000.00 to \$7,500 and changed from a surety company Bond to a personal bond with three sureties satisfactory to the Board of Trustees.

Upon motion of Trustee Carl, seconded by Trustee Pinkham, the Special Contingent fund of \$1,700.00 was ordered transferred to the General Fund and the Clerk and Treasurer directed to make the necessary entries upon their books required to consummate the transfer.

there being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
