Minutes of October 1, 1923

The Regular Monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Monday evening, October 1, 1923 at 8:00 o'clock P.M.

Full Board Present, Trustee Clark in the Chair.

The minutes of the meetings of September 24, 1923 and September 26, 1923 were read and approved.

This being the time fixed for the reception of bids on the installation of 16 new Fire Alarm boxes, and no bids having been received, upon motion of Trustee Pinkham, seconded by Trustee Lutters, the Clerk was directed to re-advertise for bids to be received up to November 5, 1923 at 8:00 o'clock P.M.

This also being the time fixed for the reception of bids for the removal of the Pine Trees on Pine Street, and no bids having been received, upon motion of Trustee Pinkham, seconded by Trustee Deysher, the Clerk was directed to re-advertise for bids, to be received up to 8:00 o'clock P.M. on November 5, 1923.

having received and read by the Clerk, upon motion of Trustee Pinkham, seconded by Trustee Carl, the matter was referred to the Engineer to check.

A letter from Mr. Thos. O'Connell of Ross in reference to a meeting of the Tamalpais Forest Fire District was read and ordered filed.

Upon motion duly seconded the Clerk was authorized to have the bonds for the Barber Tract Job printed.

The Engineer having reported that there were a majority of signatures now to the petition for sidewalks on Medway Road, upon motion of Trustee Deysher, seconded by Trustee Lutters, the Engineer was directed to prepare plans and specifications for the installation of the 4 foot sidewalk petitioned for on both sides of Medway Road.

Upon motion of Trustee Lutters, seconded by Trustee Carl, it was ordered that in the event a deed is received from the Railroad Company for the right of way required to make the proper approach to the Lansdale bridge, and said deed is satisfactory to the Town Attorney, that same be approved by the Mayor on behalf of the Board and that the Clerk be authorized to have same recorded.

Reports from the Fire Chief and Bldg Inspector were received and ordered filed.

A map of a subdivision of Block "U" of Fairfax Manor having been presented for approval, the map was referred to the City Planning Commission to report back at the next meeting.

Upon motion duly seconded, demands Nos. 116 to inclusive as appear upon the demand and warrant register under this date were ordered paid.

MINUTES OF OCTOBER 15, 1923

A Regular Adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday evening October 15, 1923 at 8:00 o'clock P.M.

Full Board present; Trustee Clark in the Chair.

The minutes of the meeting of October 1, 1923 were read and approved.

This being the time fixed for the reception of bids on the Barber Tract Road Improvement Bonds issued under the proceedings commencing with Resolution of Intention No. 41 of this Board, and no bids being received, the matter was laid over to new business.

A petition for the improvement of a portion of Greenfield Avenue in San Rafael Heights, reading as follows:
