All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the Town of San Anselmo, certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Said sealed proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Town Clerk of the Board of Trustees of said Town, on or before 8 o'clock P.M., on Tuesday, the 20th day of October, 1925, said time being not less than ten days from the time of the first posting and publication of the notice of said work and inviting sealed proposals, on which day and hour all proposals or bids will be publicly opened by said Board of Trustees.

MINUTES OF OCTOBER 13, 1925.

A Regular Adjourned Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held in the Town Hall on Tuesday evening, October 13, 1925, at the hour of 8 o'clock. There were present at said Meeting Trustees Peyton, Carl, Pinkham and Deysher. Absent, Trustee Clark; Trustee Carl acting as Chairman.

The reading of the Minutes of October 5th and 8th was dispensed with.

ISSUANCE OF BONDS:(Morningside Court - Imp. No. 51)

Trustee Peyton introduced an order for the issuance of bonds to represent the unpaid assessments on work and improvement done in Morningside Court, under Resolution of Intention No. 51, fixing the amount of the bonds, numbers, serials and interest coupons, etc., and moved its adoption. Motion to adopt said order was seconded by Trustee Carl and carried by the following vote:

Communication from Marin Municipal Water District relative to turning over water system in Morningside Court, was read and referred to the City Attorney for an opinion.

Letter from First Asst. Postmaster General relative to establishing mail delivery in Town was read and ordered filed.

BOLINAS AVE. IMPROVEMENT:

Upon motion of Trustee Deysher, seconded by Trustee Peyton, the Clerk was instructed to return the petition for the improvement of Bolinas Ave. to Mr. Baum for additional signatures.

BUTTERFIELD ROAD IMPROVEMENT:

Trustee Pinkham moved that the Chairman of the Street Committee and Town Engineer attend the meeting at the home of Mr. Borello on Wednesday evening, October 14th, at 8:30, for the purpose of discussing the improvement of Butterfield Road.

REPORTS: Trustee Pinkham reported that he attended the last meeting of the Sanitary Board and asked that some definite action be taken by it in the matter of the Spruce St. sewer. After much discussion the Sanitary Board claim that inasmuch as they were without funds no immediate action could be taken.
