

## MINUTES OF OCTOBER 20, 1925.

A Regular Adjourned Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo was held in the Town Hall on Tuesday evening, October 20, 1925 at the hour of 8 o'clock.

There were present at said Meeting Trustees Peyton, Carl, Pinkham and Deysher. Absent, Trustee Clark. Trustee Carl in the Chair.

The reading of the last three meetings was dispensed with.

FOREST AVE. JOB - BIDS:

This being the time fixed for the reception of bids on the work proposed to be done on Forest Ave. under Resolution of Intention #65 of this Board, the Clerk was directed to open and declare the bids received and the Clerk did thereupon open and declare the bids which were at unit prices, totaling as follows:

From F.J.Main.....	\$ 6306.65
" Pacific States Con.Co.	6470.47
" A.G.Raisch & Co.....	7400.90

The bids were referred to the Engineer to check and report back later.

The Engineer having reported that the bid of F.J. Main on Forest Ave. job was the lowest and best bid and was in his opinion a good bid, Trustee Peyton introduced a Resolution of Award awarding the contract to F.J. Main at the prices named in his bid and moved its adoption. Motion to adopt said Resolution was seconded by Trustee Pinkham and carried by the following vote:

PETITIONS:

A petition from C.G. Wehrli for operating a curb pump and underground gasoline tank at #16 Greenfield Ave. was read. Upon motion of Trustee Deysher, seconded by Trustee Pinkham, permission was granted.

A request signed by Emil A. Scherding and Maynor C. Clark for permission to build and operate a steel construction auto filling station, comfort station, 10 gal. Visible Type with two 500 gal. tanks located on the Southeasterly corner of the State Highway and Barber Ave. was read. Upon motion of Trustee Deysher, seconded by

Trustee Pinkham, request was granted.

Upon motion of Trustee Peyton, the Town Attorney was instructed to amend the present ordinance governing Service Stations, allowing visible gasoline pumps to be used in the future. This motion was seconded by Trustee Deysher and carried by the following vote:

A petition for temporary street repairs on Scenic Road, signed by numerous property owners in the vicinity was read. Upon motion of Trustee Pinkham, request was denied. Motion was seconded by Trustee Peyton and carried by the following vote:

COMMUNICATIONS:

Letter from H. Vandel calling the Board's attention to street sweeping in vicinity of Bolinas Ave. was read. Trustee Peyton reported that the matter had been taken care of and ordered communication filed.

BOLINAS AVE.

Trustee Pinkham moved that the Chairman of Street Committee attend the next regular meeting of the Town Trustees of Ross for the purpose of discussing the Bolinas Ave. Improvement problem. Motion was seconded by Trustee Deysher and carried by the following vote:

Upon motion of Trustee Peyton, Trustee Carl, as Chairman pro-tem of the Board of Trustees was authorized to affix his signature to warrants Nos. 565 to 584, inc. for payment. Motion was seconded by Trustee Pinkham and carried by the following vote:
