MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 6TH, 1927.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held in the Council Chambers on Tuesday, September 6th, 1927 at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

PETITIONS:

A petition bearing the signatures of members of the San Anselmo Rotary Club, urging the Council to take action before the Railroad Commission to the end that the North Western Pacific Railroad Company be required to properly safe guard the Tunstead, Ross and Bolinas Aves. crossings, by means of safety gates or flagmen, was read; also a communication from the Railroad Commission calling the Council's attention to the fact that the Bolinas Ave. crossing is not properly protected by an advance warning sign, as provided under Section No. 117 of the California Vehicle Act, was read and upon motion of Councilman Hensley, the Clerk was instructed to refer the <sup>entire</sup> matter to the Railroad Commission and to advise them that the Council will conform to every regulation required of them in connection with the necessary procedure.
