

MINUTES OF DECEMBER 2, 1929.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Monday, December 2nd, 1929, at the hour of 9 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Siemer, Fusselman, Smith, Hensley and Schmidt
Absent: None.

Councilman Schmidt presiding.

The minutes of the meetings of November 4 and 5th were read and approved.

COMMUNICATIONS:

A letter from M.S. Edgar, Health Officer of San Anselmo, advising Council of his recent investigation and finding the sewer system of Sequoia Park in a very unsanitary condition, was read and placed on file.

The bid of Roy L. Seavey in the amount of \$60. for the removal of an eucalyptus tree at Ross Ave. and Cedar St. was referred to the Street Committee for consideration.

A communication signed E. A. Brooks, calling Council's attention to several faulty conditions along Oak Ave. was read and referred to the Engineer for investigation.

A communication from Allen Christensen Co. in reference to insurance law recently enacted by the Legislature was read and referred to the Attorney.

The lighting contract between the P.G. & E. Co. and the Town was referred to the Finance Committee.

ORDINANCE #204 - REPEALING ORDINANCE #203:

An Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 203, which was passed and adopted by the Council on October 21st, 1929 was presented for first reading and was read.

ISSUANCE OF BONDS (ELM COURT) RESOLUTION OF INTENTION #89:

This being the time set for the hearing of protests against assessment described in Resolution of Intention No. 89, and no protests having been received by the Clerk, Councilman Hensley introduced a Resolution authorizing the issuance of bonds to represent the unpaid assessments on the work and improvement of Elm Court done under Resolution of Intention No. 89, fixing the amount of bonds, number, serials and interest coupons, etc., and moved its adoption. Resolution was seconded by Councilman Smith and carried by the following vote:

The matter of payment of certain warrants in favor of the

officers serving on the Board at the Hawthorn Hills Annexation Election on April 29th, 1929, was referred to the Attorney for his opinion.

Mr. Flaherty addressed the Council relative to tree on the premises of Mrs. Wyatt, which adjoins his property, and stated that in his opinion said tree was a menace to life and limb and requested the Council to investigate.

Upon motion of Councilman Fusselman, Warrants Nos. 203 to 250, inclusive, were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Hensley and carried by the following vote:
