MINUTES OF APRIL 15, 1930.

An adjourned meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, April 15th, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Siemer, Fusselman, Smith and Schmidt.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

ACQUISITION AND IMPROVEMENT DIST. NO. 2 (BRIDGE JOB #94): The Superintendent of work having filed with the Clerk a Declaration upon completion of contract in the matter of the Acquisition and Improvement District No. 2 of the Town of San Anselmo, which work was done under Resolution of Intention No. 94,

Councilman Smith introduced a Resolution fixing the time and place for hearing on acceptance of work and issuance of bonds and moved its adoption. Resolution was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

ORDINANCE NO. 205 :

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the Town of San Anselmo to execute on behalf of said Town a contract of sale of the water distributing system in Morningside Court #2 to the Marin Municipal Water District for the sum of Three Thousand seven hundred and seventy dollars and eighteen cents (\$3770.18) was presented for first reading and was read. Thereupon, Councilman Fusselman introduced Resolution No. 92-A, adopting a form of contract to be entered into by the Town of San Anselmo with the Marin Municipal Water District for the sale to said Water District of the water distributing system now owned by the Town in Morningside Court No. 2 for the consideration of Three Thousand seven hundred and seventy and 18/100 (\$3770.18) Dollars, and moved its adoption. Resolution was seconded by Councilman Smith and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Siemer, Fusselman, Smith and Schmidt.

Absent: Councilman Hensley.

A communication signed A. Mansie, protesting against the granting of a permit to Mr. Schuler to erect a 10 foot fence along his property line, was read and after some discussion both parties agreed to meet with members of the Council at a later date to settle their differences and abolish the idea of the erection of the fence in question.

The Clerk was directed to communicate with Mr. Maggard in regard to the Railroad Company's suggested plan of improving the underpass in the vicinity of the new bridge.

The Chief of Police was authorized to sell the old underground gasoline storage tank at a reasonable figure after submitting the proposition to the Police and Fire Committee, for approval.
