

## MINUTES OF APRIL 21, 1930.

An adjourned meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Monday, April 21, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilman Siemer, Fusselman, Smith, Hensley and Schmidt.

Absent: None.

Councilman Schmidt presiding.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

CANVASS OF ELECTION:

The Board thereupon proceeded to canvass the returns of the General Municipal election held on Monday, April 14th, 1930, and having ascertained the result of the vote cast, Councilman Smith introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

"WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held and conducted in the Town of San Anselmo, on Monday, the 14th day of April, 1930, as required by law, and

WHEREAS, it appears that notice of said election was held and legally given, that voting precincts were properly established, that election officers were appointed, and election supplies were furnished, and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat received and canvassed and the returns thereof made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the general laws of the state governing elections in cities of the fifth and sixth class; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of said town met at the Council chambers of the Board on Monday, the 21st day of April, 1930, to canvass the returns of said election and install the newly elected officers as a result of which the Board finds that the number of votes cast, the names of the persons voted for, and other matters required by law to be as hereinafter stated;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

That said regular municipal election was held and conducted in the Town of San Anselmo on Monday, the 14th day of April, 1930, in time, form and matter as required by law; and that there were three voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election, consisting of a consolidation of the regular election precincts established for holding general state and county elections, as follows:

Consolidated Voting Precinct "A", comprising State and County precincts Nos. 1, 2 and 4;

Consolidated Voting Precinct "B", comprising State and County precincts Nos. 3 and 8;

Consolidated Voting Precinct "C", comprising State and County precincts Nos. 5, 6, 7 and 9;

That the whole number of votes cast in said town was 1154 and that the names of the persons voted for, the offices for which said persons, together with the number of votes which they received in the entire town are as follows:

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that at said general municipal election Charles Wright, John A. Jordan and William F. McKannay were elected to the office of Councilman of the Town of San Anselmo for the full term of four years.

The Clerk shall enter on the records of the Board a statement of the result of the election showing (1) the whole number of votes cast in said town, (2) the names of the persons voted for, (3) the office which each person was voted for, (4) number of votes given in each precinct to each of said persons, (5) the number of votes given in said town to each of said persons;

The Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons elected a certificate of election signed by him and duly authenticated, he shall also impose the constitutional Oath of Office and have them subscribe thereto, whereupon, they shall be inducted into the respective offices to which they have been elected".

Motion to adopt said resolution was seconded by Councilman Hensley and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Siemer, Fusselman, Smith, Hensley and Schmidt.  
Noes: None.

The three newly elected Councilmen, Charles Wright, John A. Jordan and William F. McKannay took the constitutional Oath of Office and were seated as members of the Council.

Councilman Siemer moved that Councilman Fusselman be placed in nomination for Chairman or President of the City Council, which motion was seconded by Councilman McKannay.

Thereupon, Councilman Jordan moved that Councilman Wright be placed in nomination for the office of Chairman or President of the City Council.

There being no second to said motion, a vote was taken on the nomination of Councilman Fusselman, as Chairman or President of the City Council, with the following results: Ayes: Councilmen Siemer, Fusselman and McKannay; Noes: Jordan and Wright. Thereafter, Councilman Fusselman was declared elected and took the chair and appointed the following Committees:

- Finance: Councilmen McKannay, Chairman, and Siemer, Member.
- Streets: Councilmen Jordan, Chairman, and Wright, Member.
- Fire and Police: Councilmen Wright, Chairman, McKannay, Member.
- Parks and Housing: Councilmen Siemer, Chairman, Jordan, Member.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned to Monday, April 28, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.
