

MINUTES OF APRIL 28, 1930.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Monday, April 28, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

PRESENT: Councilmen McKannary, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

ABSENT: None.

Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and upon motion of Councilman Jordan, the following amendment was made thereto: The withdrawal of Councilman Wright's nomination to the office of Chairman or President of the City Council, and the recording of a unanimous vote in favor of Councilman Fusselman for such office.

ACQUISITION AND IMPROVEMENT DIST. NO. 2 (Bridge Job):

This being the time set by the Council for the acceptance of the work and also for protests against the issuance of bonds for the work and improvement done under Acquisition and Improvement District No. 2, of this Council, and no protests having been filed with the Clerk, Councilmen Wright introduced a resolution accepting the work and fixing the amount of bonds, and moved its adoption. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Wright and Fusselman,
Noes: Councilman Jordan declined to vote.

ORDINANCE NO. 205 - SALE OF WATER DISTRIBUTING SYSTEM MORNINGSIDE CT. #2;

Upon motion duly made and seconded an Ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the Town of San Anselmo to execute on behalf of the Town, a contract of sale of the water distributing system in Morningside Court No. 2, to the Marin Municipal Water District was presented for final reading, was read, and thereafter passed and adopted by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

The Ordinance was then signed by the Mayor and numbered 205.

ORDINANCE NO. 206 - PROHIBITING DISTRIBUTION OF HAND BILLS, ETC.:

Upon motion duly made and carried, an Ordinance prohibiting the distribution of hand bills, circulars, etc. was presented for final reading and was read. Thereafter, ^{the attorney representing} "The Shopping News" appeared before the Council and requested a delay of one week in the adoption of said Ordinance. Upon motion of Councilman Jordan, seconded by Councilman Siemer, the request was

granted by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and
Fusselman.
Noes: None.

PETITIONS:

The petition of Jessie E. Weeden, asking Council to co-operate with the property owners of the district in rebuilding steps along an 8 foot right of way between Allyn and Floribel Aves. was read and referred to the Street Committee for consideration.

The applications of Robert A. Meagor, John A. Locati and Leo Manning for positions in the Fire and Police Departments were read and referred to the Fire and Police Committees for consideration.

The matter of the removal of a light standard from in front of the Fire house, was referred to the Street and Fire Committees for consideration.

The Chairman of Parks and Housing Committee reported that he authorized the issuance of a building permit to the Northwestern Pacific R.R. Co. for the erection of a shelter shed west of the right of way and opposite the Main depot in San Anselmo, contrary to the building ordinance.

Upon motion of Councilman Jordan, seconded by Councilman Wright, such action was upheld by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and
Fusselman.
Noes: None.

The Clerk was directed to write to the Superintendent of the Northwestern Pacific R.R. Co. in regard to replacing the sidewalk which was torn up in double tracking across Main St. some months ago, and to advise Council at its next meeting just when such work would be done.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Monday, May 5th, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.
