MINUTES OF MAY 23, 1930.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Friday, May 23rd, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Absent: None.

The reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

Upon motion of Councilman Wright, the office of Fire Chief was declared vacant. Motion was seconded by Councilman McKannay and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Upon motion of Councilman Siemer, Charles Cartwright was appointed Fire Marshall at a salary of \$140.00, his duties consisting as follows, as outlined in Ordinance No. 16, amended:

Complete charge of Fire Alarm System, inspection and maintenance of hydrants, inspection and investigation of all conflagrations after they are out, reporting such matters to the Fire Committee. Hours from 8 A.M. to 5 P.M., assisting in the care of fire apparatus and answering fire calls day and night in capacity of fireman. Also to act as Building and Electrical inspector, and reporting to Parks and Housing Committee. Approximately one day per week will be spent in inspecting buildings, etc. and one day a week on fire alarm and hydrant inspection. He will be permitted to continue his duties for the Library Board.

Motion was seconded by Councilman McKannay and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Upon motion of Councilman Wright, Nello Marcucci was appointed Chief of the Fire Department, at his present salary, his duties consisting as follows:

Usual duties of Fire Chief, with exception of those assigned to the Fire Marshall. Complete charge of all fire apparatus and at all fires, reporting to the Fire Committee. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

The Chairman of the Street Committee was authorized to survey the present lighting system of the Town and to confer with the P.G. & E. Co.

with the view to reducing the present lighting contract.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Monday, June 2nd, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.
