

MINUTES OF JUNE 2ND, 1930.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Monday, June 2nd, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

Absent: None.

Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the previous meetings of May 5th and 23rd were read and approved.

Upon motion of Councilman McKannay, Dr. Robert L. Taylor and Mrs. O. W. Jones were reappointed members of the Library Board for the ensuing term, and the Clerk was directed to notify the appointees and to thank them on behalf of the Town for past services.

By motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Town accepted the conveyance from Thos. T. Kent, et ux, covering three certain parcels designated and described as "Park" upon the Map of Hawthorn Hills, recorded on April 9th, 1920, in Map Book 5 at Page 9 Marin County Records, and the Clerk was directed to write a letter of thanks on behalf of the Town.

The petition of Joseph Cordone and others for the installation of street lights in the Cordone Tract was read and referred to the Street Committee for investigation.

The petition of Mrs. H.J. Ott for the removal of trees in the vicinity of 139 Humboldt Ave. was read and referred to the Parks and Housing Committee.

A letter signed by the Chief of the Fire Department recommending certain purchases for the department was read and referred to the Chairman of the Fire Committee, thereafter, upon motion of Councilman Jordan, the Chairman was given full power to make such purchases as he deemed necessary. Motion was seconded by Councilman McKannay and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilman McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

Noes: None.

A communication signed W.M. Rutherford, recommending the appointment of Carl Lezzene as Special Officer of the Ball Park was read and upon motion of Councilman Wright, such appointment was directed to be made after appointee had filed a satisfactory bond with the Chief of Police. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the

following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

A petition bearing several hundred names of residents of San Anselmo asking Council to take the necessary steps to develop the Park Play Grounds was read and the matter was referred to the Clerk for checking names of property owners, and thereafter to the Parks and Housing Committee with instructions to report back at next regular meeting of the Council.

A communication from the Sanitary District Board No. 1 in reference to the Sequoia Park sewer was read and the Clerk was directed to furnish a copy of such letter to Mr. Honeyman and the Sequoia Improvement Association.

A communication signed A. Mansie, protesting against the erection of a 10 ft. fence between his property and that of Mr. Shuler, his neighbor, was read and the writer being present, was advised that the matter would be gone into thoroughly after the attorney returned from his vacation.

ORDINANCE NO. 207.

An Ordinance regulating traffic upon public streets of the Town of San Anselmo was presented for first reading.

WARRANTS: Upon motion of Councilman McKannay, Warrants Nos. 474 and 485, also warrants Nos. 516 to 532 inclusive, also warrants Nos. 534 to 575 inclusive were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

The reports of the Building Inspector and Fire Chief for the month of May were received and placed on file.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Monday, July 7th, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.
