A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Wednesday, November 5th, 1930, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of October 22nd were read and approved.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the paragraph concerning the manner in which the City Judge's appointment was made was ordered stricken out of the minutes.

This being the time and place set by the Council for the

The Constitution of the Marin County Association of Fire Departments was endorsed by the Council.

The minutes of the last regular meeting of the above mentioned Association were read and placed on file and the Clerk was instructed to acknowledge receipt thereof.

A communication signed Andrew W. Jensen, Civil Engineer, 68 Post Street, San Francisco, requesting information concerning zoning of property in the Town of San Anselmo was referred to the Parks & Housing Committee.

The communication from The League of California Municipalities, offering the sale of a booklet containing printed proceedings of its 1930 Convention held at Long Beach, California, was read and referred to the Finance Committee for consideration.

The reports of the Fire Chief, Building Inspector and Fire Marshal for the month of October, 1930, were received and placed on file.

ORDINANCE NO. 202:

An Ordinance imposing license fees on businesses, professions, callings, trades or occupations, transacted or carried on within the Town of San Anselmo was presented for first reading.

AWARD OF CONTRACT (KARLSHRUE PARK):

The Engineer, having computed the several bids and reporting the bid of F. J. Main the lowest and best bid, Councilman Jordan introduced a Resolution of Award of Contract to F. J. Main at the figure mentioned in his bid, and moved its adoption. Resolution was seconded by Councilman Wright and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.  
Noes: None: Absent: Councilman McKannay.

Thereafter, the Clerk was directed to return certified checks to the unsuccessful bidders.

Upon motion of Councilman Wright, seconded by Councilman Jordan, the appointment of Bert Meagor to the position of relief man in the Fire Department failed to carry by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.  
Noes: Councilmen Siemer and Fusselman.

There being no further business, a vote was taken for adjournment with the following result:

Ayes: Councilmen Siemer and Fusselman.  
Noes: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

A deadlock apparently resulting, Councilman Siemer left the meeting and was followed shortly thereafter by Councilman Fusselman, leaving the Council without a quorum; thereupon the meeting was automatically adjourned.
