

MINUTES OF JUNE 20TH, 1931.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Saturday, June 20th, 1931, at the hour of 10:30 o'clock A.M.

Present: Councilmen Siemer, Jordan and Fusselman.

Absent: Councilmen McKannay and Wright.

Upon motion duly made and carried, Councilman Siemer was appointed Clerk Protem.

Councilman Jordan introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"WHEREAS, there appears on the official records of the Town of San Anselmo and more particularly described in the Delinquent Roll, the following described property, to-wit:

upon which has been assessed certain streets assessments, and said assessments with interest and penalties accruing under the taxation ordinance of the Town of San Anselmo have not been paid, and

WHEREAS, the Improvement Bond Act of 1915 as amended provides that the City Council may order the same to be collected by suit brought in the Superior Court to foreclose the lien thereof,

IT IS NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Town Attorney be, and is hereby directed to institute the necessary legal proceedings to collect said delinquent assessments, with interest, penalties and costs, as by Statute provided."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

MINUTES OF JULY 14, 1931.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, July 14th, 1931, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.  
Absent: None.

Councilman Fusselman presiding. The minutes of the Meeting of June 9th, and 20th were approved as read.

The petition of Mrs. L. Gandolfo and others for the installation of a light on the lower end of City Hall Ave. was read and referred to the Lighting Committee.

Communications from the San Anselmo Post of the American Legion and the Sequoia Park Improvement Club, concerning the widening of Red Hill Ave. were read and placed on file and the Clerk was directed to acknowledge receipt of same.

The annual report of the Library Board for the year ending June 30th, 1931 was read and placed on file and upon motion of Councilman Siemer, the Clerk was directed to acknowledge same and to inform the Secretary that a vote of thanks was extended to the entire Board for the efficient manner in which its affairs have been handled. Motion was seconded by Councilman McKannay and carried by the following vote:
