



MINUTES OF AUGUST 27TH, 1931.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, August 27th, 1931, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Absent: None.

Councilman Fusselman presiding. The reading of the minutes of the meeting of August 11th, 1931 was dispensed with.

TAX RATE:- 1931-32:

Upon motion of Councilman McKannay, the tax rate for the year 1931-32 was fixed at \$1.77 per \$100. valuation. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Councilman Wright introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that the offices of Chief of Police and Judge in said Town be, and the same are hereby, declared vacant."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Jordan and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Councilman McKannay introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that the salary of, and to be attached to the office of, Chief of Police in the said Town be, and the same is hereby, fixed at Two Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$225.00) per month."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Councilman McKannay introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that Donald T. Wood be, and he hereby is, appointed to the office of Chief of Police of said Town at a salary of Two Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$225.00) per month; said appointment to take effect immediately."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Councilman McKannay introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that the salary of, and to be attached to the office of, Judge in the said Town be, and the same is hereby, fixed at Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00) per month."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman
Noes: None.

Councilman McKannay introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that George G. Washburn be, and he hereby is, appointed to the office of Judge of said Town at a salary of Fifty-Five Dollars (\$55.00) per month; said appointment to take effect immediately."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Councilman McKannay introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

~~"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that hereafter Main Street, from the Southerly boundary line of said Town Northerly to its intersection with the Northerly line of Red Hill Avenue, and Red Hill Avenue from its intersection with the Easterly line of Main Street Westerly to the Westerly boundary line of said Town, shall be officially known as, and called, 'Sir Francis Drake Highway'".~~

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Upon motion of Councilman Wright, the salary of the Fire Chief was increased from \$175. to \$200. per month. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Upon motion of Councilman McKannay, the salary of R.M. Overdick was increased from \$50. to \$65. per month. Motion was seconded by Councilman Wright and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
