

MINUTES OF OCTOBER 13, 1931.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, October 13th, 1931, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

Absent: None.

Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of September 8th were read and approved.

The bid of \$200. for blasting the rock ledge in the Cordone Creek, submitted by Ernest Arhini was considered too high and was rejected.

Upon motion of Councilman McKannay, Councilman Siemer was authorized to have the work done at a more reasonable figure. Motion was seconded by Councilman Wright and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilman McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Upon motion of Councilman Jordan, the bid of \$55. for paving at the intersection of Sir Francis Drake and San Francisco Boulevards, submitted by F. J. Main, was accepted. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

Upon motion of Councilman Jordan, the bid of \$650. for the purchase of the Northeast corner of Saunders Ave. and Taylor St., submitted by R. A. Carey & Co., for its client, Flora Culver, was accepted and the and the Chairman was authorized to execute same on behalf of the Town. Attorney was instructed to draw the necessary deed. Motion was seconded by Councilman McKannay and carried by the following vote:

The request of Edward Barron for the removal of a tree at No. 16 Foothill Road was read and the matter was referred to the Parks & Housing Committee for consideration with the full power to act.

The petition of Felix A. Renaud and others for a sidewalk to be built along the East side of Sir Francis Drake Blvd. from Barber Ave. to the existing sidewalk, leading to Bolinas Ave. Station was read and the Clerk was directed to write the several property owners affected urging them to lay sidewalks fronting their property, under private contract, thereby avoiding extra expense if such work were ordered done by the Council.

A communication signed A. C. Presley, Jr. requesting certain repairs at the entrance of Yolanda Court was read and the Clerk was instruct-

ed to write Mr. Presley advising him that there is a plan on foot at the present time by certain property owners in said Court to change the design of the entrance thereto and for this reason no action has been taken by the Council towards repairing the present structure.

A communication signed George E. Kendall, 1015 Redhill Ave., requesting Council to take up with the Municipal Water District and the Telephone Company the matter of restoring the street fronting his property to its original condition was read and placed on file. Councilman Siemer reported that the matter has already been taken care of.

A letter signed Effie M. Brown offering to purchase from the Town a small strip of land adjoining her property at 22 Suffield Ave. was read and after some discussion the Attorney ruled that inasmuch as this parcel is designated on the original map of Hawthorn Hills as a "Park", same having been deeded by Thomas T. Kent to the Town as such, no sale can be made of such parcel of land.

The reports of the Marin County Association of Fire Departments, Fire Chief and Building Inspector for the month of September, 1931, were received and placed on file.

WARRANTS: Upon motion of Councilman McKannay, Warrants Nos. 180 to 205, inclusive, and also Warrants Nos. 207 to 255, inclusive, were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Siemer and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.

The Chair appointed Robert Carey to head a Committee to confer with the Manager of the Marin Municipal Water District with the view to having said District build an eight foot fence along its property line, thus preventing deer from trespassing on private property in the Town.

A card of thanks for a floral offering from Mrs. Reeves and family was received and placed on file.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, November 10, 1931 at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.
