ORDINANCE NO. 215 REGULATING SIGN BOARDS:

An Ordinance regulating the erection and maintenance of business signboards and electric signboards was presented for first reading and was read.

The consent of the Town Attorney to the cancellation of taxes covering Lot 14, Block D, Amended Map No. 2 of the Carrigan Tract, and Lot 4, Block 2, Map of Hawthorn Hills, Sub. 2, having been obtained, upon motion of Councilman Siemer, the Clerk was directed to cancel such assessments. Motion was seconded by Councilman Jordan and carried by the following vote:

Councilman McKannay reported that Gordon Rowe had been given the contract for auditing the books and accounts of the Town covering a period of one and a half years at a figure of \$240.00 and informed the Council that a complete report will be rendered on or about the 1st of April.

Mr. Frank Nash addressed the Council, extending them and all residents a cordial invitation to attend the Sunrise Service to be held on Red Hill at 6 A.M. on Easter Sunday.

MINUTES OF APRIL 15, 1932.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Friday, April 15th, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. Present: Councilmen McKannay, Siemer, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman. Absent: None.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The application of H. J. Kemp for a permit to remove a portion of the sidewalk and curb and to install a driveway into his establishment at No. 633 San Anselmo Ave. was read and referred to the Street Committee for consideration.

The communication of Mr. Niebauer requesting Council to have certain trees trimmed in the vicinity of his home at 52 Laurel Ave. was read and referred to the Street and Parks and Housing Committee for consideration.

The communication of Mr. Neff of the Northwestern Pacific R.R. Co. concerning the removal of the old foot bridge under its trestle in the vicinity of the new highway bridge was read and the matter was referred to the Street Committee for investigation.

A communication from the Memorial Day Observance Committee of the American Legion, inviting Council and residents of the Town to participate in the celebration to be held in San Rafael on May 30th, 1932, at the hour of 9:45 A.M. was read and placed on file.

TREASURER'S SALARY INCREASE:

Councilman Jordan introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that the salary or compensation of the office of Treasurer of the Town of San Anselmo be, and the same is, hereby fixed at the sum of Forty (\$40) Dollars per month for each of the months of April, May and June, 1932, and at the sum of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) per month from and after the first day of July, 1932."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman McKannay

and carried by the following vote:

Noes: None.

Councilman McKannay reported at length on the recent audit of the Town's books and accounts, which were found to be in good order.
