MINUTES OF MAY 2, 1932.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Monday, May 2, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Scotford, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

Absent: None.

Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the two previous meetings were read and approved.

Upon motion of Councilman Scotford, the temporary suspension of Officer Thomas J. Lynch of the Police Department was declared permanent. Motion was seconded by Councilman McKannay and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Scotford, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.

Noes: None.

Thomas P. Boyd, representing the Board of Directors and members of the Marin Co. Farm Bureau, addressed the Council and protested the formation of a Public Utility District to operate and maintain a Ferry and Bus Service in the County, believing that public interest or necessity does not require the organization of such a district and presented the Council with a copy of a Resolution of such protest which was unanimously passed and adopted at a meeting of the Farm Bureau, held on May 2nd, 1932. The Resolution was read and placed on file.

The members of the Bureau also petitioned the Council to rescind the Resolution passed by said Council on March 8th, 1932, in favor of creating the "Marin Municipal Utility District", believing that the matter should be given further consideration. It was agreed that both factions would meet with the Council at an early date for a general discussion.

Thereafter, Councilman McKannay introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

"WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo did on the 8th day of March, 1932, adopt a resolution wherein and whereby it declared in said resolution, among other things, that, in the opinion of the members of this council public interest or necessity demands the creation and maintenance of a municipal utility district to be known as the "Marin Municipal Utility District"; and

WHEREAS, it now appears to the satisfaction of this council that there may be a question whether the public interest or necessity does demand the creation and maintenance of such a municipal utility district, and that the matter should be given further consideration by said Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the resolution of this Council adopted, as aforesaid, on March 8, 1932, be and the same is hereby rescinded and declared void, and of no effect, and that the Board of Supervisors of Marin County be immediately notified by the Town Clerk of this action by said Council."

Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Scotford, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.  
None: None.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, May 10th, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.
