MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF JULY 21, 1932.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on July 21, 1932 at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of passing upon and accepting the Map of Hawthorn Hills, Sub-division No. 3.

Present: Councilman McKannay, Scotford, and Fusselman.  
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

Councilman Fusselman presiding.

Upon the recommendation of the Planning Commission and motion of Councilman McKannay, Map No. 3 of Hawthorn Hills was accepted by the Council with the understanding that standpipes, gutters and proper drainage be installed, the latter to be maintained by the owner of the tract throughout the winter, to prevent damage arising through slides, settling of fills, etc., also that adequate blind street signs and safety guards be installed in the several locations, as agreed upon by the Superintendent of Streets and the owner of said tract. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

ORDINANCE NO. 216: AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 207 (TRAFFIC REGULATION):
