A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Sam Anselmo was called on Tuesday, September 13, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

Absent: Councilmen McKannay, Scotford and Fusselman.

There not being a quorum present, the meeting was adjourned to Thursday, September 22nd, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. Upon being questioned by the Chair, Councilman Jordan stated above minutes were correct.

MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 22nd, 1932.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Sam Anselmo was held on Thursday, September 22nd, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen McKannay, Scotford, Jordan and Fusselman.

Absent: Councilman Wright.

Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the meetings of July 21, August 8, August 9 and September 13, 1932 were read and approved.

The petition of C. DeWitt and others for the installation of lights along Rutherford Ave. and Camino de Herrera was read and the Clerk was directed to invite the petitioners to appear before the Council to discuss the matter.

A letter from Mrs. Jones informing Council of Dr. Jones' absence from Town and stating that upon his return the matter of constructing sidewalks fronting his property on Pine Street would be considered by him was read and placed on file.

WARRANTS:

Upon motion of Councilman McKannay, Warrants Nos. 60 to 132, inclusive, were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen McKannay, Scotford, Jordan and Fusselman.

Noes: None.

Absent: Councilman Wright.

Councilman McKannay tendered his written resignation to the Board and upon motion of Councilman Scotford, seconded by Councilman Fusselman, same was accepted by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Fusselman, Scotford and Jordan.

Noes: None.

Absent: Councilman Wright.

Thereafter, upon motion of Councilman Scotford, Thomas L. Dempsey was appointed Councilman of the Town of Sam Anselmo to finish out

the unexpired term of Councilman McKannay, resigned.

Motion was seconded by Councilman Fusselman and carried by the following vote;

Ayes: Councilmen Fusselman and Scotford.
Noes: Councilman Jordan.
Absent: Councilman Wright.

The Clerk then administered the Oath of Office to the newly appointed Councilman, who, after being duly sworn, took his seat and was appointed Chairman of the Finance Committee and Member of the Police and Fire Commissions.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, October 11th, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

MINUTES OF OCTOBER 11, 1932.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, October 11th, 1932, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

WARRANTS: Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, Warrants Nos. 133 to 155, incl., also warrants Nos. 157 to 189, incl. were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

Noes: None.
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

Upon motion of Councilman Scotford, the Mayor was authorized to execute a deed to Ida Louise Raas covering portion of Lot 3, Blk.1, Idalia Park. Motion was seconded by Councilman Dempsey and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

The reports of the Building Inspector, Fire Chief and Fire Marshall for the month of September were read and placed on file.

Councilman Scotford reported the sale of 2 motorcycles belonging to the Town at a price of approximately \$200, and recommended that the Fire Department purchase an air compressor ^{and receiver} for a fire whistle. Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, the Chairman of the Fire Committee was authorized to purchase such a compressor at a figure not to exceed ^{approx.} \$240. Motion was seconded by Councilman Fusselman and carried by the following vote:
