MINUTES OF MAY 2ND, 1933.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, May 2nd, 1933, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford and Fusselman.
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.
Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 162:

"An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 162, as amended by Ordinance No. 175, and as further amended by Ordinance No. 192, by repealing certain sections thereof", was presented for first reading and was read.

ORDINANCE NO. 218 - TAXES:

The Ordinance presented for first reading at the meeting of April 25th, amending Section 20 of Ordinance No. 155, entitled "An Ordinance providing for the assessment, levy and collection of taxes in the Town of San Anselmo", was presented for final reading, was read, passed and adopted by the following vote: Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

The Ordinance was then signed by the Mayor and numbered 218.

Councilman Scotford reported that the bell in the tower of the Fire House has been removed.

A serious condition in the curb area at Dykes Store, corner Florence and San Anselmo Aves. having been brought to the attention of the Council, and upon investigation it was found that the P.G. & E. Co. in laying its gas mains was responsible, the Clerk was directed to write to Mr. Ridgeway requesting that a representative of the P.G. & E. Co., with authority to act, be instructed to attend the next meeting of the Council in order that the matter may be thoroughly gone into, with the view to having necessary repairs made.

Upon motion of Councilman Scotford, the Superintendent of Streets was authorized to repair the wooden bridge on Arroyo Ave., near Butterfield Road. Motion was seconded by Councilman Dempsey and carried by the following vote: Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

A communication signed Kernan Robson protesting the manner of trimming trees in his neighborhood was read and placed on file.

Similar action was taken on the communication of Mrs. Latham, thanking Council for excluding her property from the business and fire zones.

Upon motion of Councilman Jordan, the Superintendent of Streets was authorized to make certain cuts in the pavement and curbing at Sir Francis Drake Blvd. and Tunstead Ave., along Tunstead Ave. in front of the American Trust Co.'s Bank and also at the Ross Ave. crossing in connection with the installation of new wig-wag signals at said locations. Motion was seconded by Councilman Dempsey and carried by the following vote:
