

MINUTES OF JULY 11TH, 1933.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, July 11th, 1933 at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.
Absent: Councilman Jordan.
Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the meetings of June 13th and 19th were read and after a correction concerning the use of city water pipes bringing water to the Boys Scout's Cabin, were approved.

Upon motion of Councilman Wright, the Chairman of the Fire Committee was authorized to accept the bid of \$104.50^{or better,} for the sale of the fire bell recently removed from the Tower. Motion was seconded by Councilman Dempsey and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilman Jordan.

Upon motion of Councilman Scotford, permits for the sale of vinous and malt beverages containing not more than 3.02% of alcohol by weight were issued to the following applicants:

Rathjen Bros. San Francisco,
Marin Poultry Co., San Anselmo.

Motion was seconded by Councilman Wright and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.

Absent: Councilman Jordan.

A petition bearing the signatures of L.B. Solemink and others objecting to the burning of grass on vacant lots in Morningside Court, was read and placed on file and the Clerk was instructed to acknowledge receipt of same and advise petitioners that the matter was referred to the Fire Committee.

ORDINANCE NO. 223 - ZONING:

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 190 establishing locations of trades, businesses, dwellings, zones, etc., was presented for first reading and was read.

Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, the Clerk was authorized to segregate and re-apportion certain street assessments, as per Map submitted to the Council by the Superintendent of Streets and now on file in the office of the Clerk. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilman Jordan.

Upon motion of Councilman Wright, Dr. R. L. Taylor, Sr. and Mrs. O. W. Jones were reappointed members of the Library Board and the Clerk was directed to so notify them in a letter of thanks for past services. Motion was seconded by Councilman Dempsey and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilman Jordan.

Councilman Dempsey, as Chairman of the Finance Committee, reported a surplus of \$27800.61 in the General Fund, notwithstanding the heavy delinquencies which exceeded last year by \$1500. or more.

Councilman Scotford reported that Officer Reynolds was undergoing hospital treatment for his injured foot and recommended the temporary appointment of Harry Newhart at a monthly salary of \$120., such appointment to run from July 1st, 1933. Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, seconded by Councilman Wright, such appointment was made by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilman Jordan.

Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, the Chairman of the Fire Committee was authorized to purchase a uniform for the Asst. Fire Chief at a figure of \$45. Motion was seconded by Councilman Wright and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilman Jordan.

The Mayor reported that he and Councilmen Wright and Scotford viewed the property of Mr. Gerlack in the Rosenthal Tract and found the private property notices which were reported to have been placed in the street area on Mr. Gerlack's property and that the roadway is in fact open to traffic.

The Superintendent of Streets was instructed to slope off the curbing across the sidewalk in front of the fire house.

Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, Warrants Nos. 637 to 693, inclusive, were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Wright and Fusselman.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilman Jordan.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, July 18th, 1933 at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.
