MINUTES OF AUGUST 2, 1933.

An adjourned meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Wednesday, August 2nd, 1933, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford and Fusselman.  
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

Councilman Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the meetings of July 11th, 18th and 26th, 1933 were read and approved.

A petition bearing signatures of numerous property owners, for re-zoning a section of business property fronting on San Anselmo Ave., between Bolinas and Mariposa Avenues, was read and referred to the Clerk for checking.

A resolution passed by the local Chamber of Commerce, protesting such re-zoning was read and placed on file and the Clerk was instructed to acknowledge receipt of same, advising the writer that no further action will be taken until the next meeting of the Council.

Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, the Purchasing Agent was authorized to sell one Burrough Adding Machine for the sum of \$20., which amount will be applied on the purchase of a new Victor machine. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

Noes: None.  
Absent: Councilmen Jordan and Wright.

The bid of \$50. offered by J. R. Boothe for the purchase of a parcel of land in the Rosenthal Tract was received and the matter was referred to the Finance Committee for consideration.

The following applicants were granted permits to sell malt and vinous beverages containing not more than 3.2% of alcohol by weight:

Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, the actions of the Finance Committee concerning the purchase of an International Dump Truck, Model A-2, for the sum of \$1050. were confirmed and a warrant in the sum of \$250 was

ordered drawn on the Treasury as a down payment thereon, the balance of \$800 to be paid after September 1st 1933.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, August 8th, 1933, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Upon motion of Councilman Jordan, the permit to sell malt and vinous beverages recently issued to Mr. Wolfe, Tivoli Cafe, San Anselmo, was revoked and Mabel Foster, the new proprietor of said restaurant, was granted a permit to sell such beverages. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:
