MINUTES OF OCTOBER 10, 1933.

A regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, October 10th, 1933, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of September 12th were read and approved.

Upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, a permit for the sale of malt and vinous beverages containing not more than 3.2% of alcohol by weight was granted to W.H. Gorman and E.R. Penny doing business under the firm name and

style of "Redwood Empire Distributors". Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following votes:

The petition of Frank H. Allen and others to have Council enforce the Ordinance limiting parking of vehicles on the Easterly side of Sir Francis Drake Blvd., between Bank St. and the San Anselmo Creek, to one hour between the hours of 9 A.M. and 5 P.M. was read, and upon motion of Councilman Dempsey, the Chief of Police was instructed to strictly enforce such Ordinance. Motion was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

A communication signed B. J. Schmidt, 1635 San Anselmo Ave., calling Council's attention to strong odors arising from storm sewers at San Anselmo Ave. and Medway Road, was read and the Superintendent of Streets was instructed to test pavement in the vicinity for sewer seepage, and the Clerk was directed to inform the writer of such action.

The petition of Mr. Hansen to have Council investigate the present drainage condition caused by wrongful diversion of storm waters by the owners of the Ancha Vista Hotel property was read and after some discussion the matter was referred to the Street Committee for recommendation.

A communication from the Marin Co. Contractors Assn. protesting the present licensing of such industry was read and after some discussion it was suggested that the matter be held over and gone into more thoroughly at the next meeting of the Council.

Upon motion of Councilman Scotford, the inhalator recently purchased by the San Anselmo Firemen's Club and subsequently presented to the Town was formally accepted by the Council. Motion was seconded by Councilman Dempsey and carried by the following vote:
