
A special meeting of the City Council of

growing within the street areas.






MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 28TH, 1933.

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, November 28th, 1933, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Jordan, Wright and Fusselman.
Absent: None.
Mayor Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of November 14th were approved as read.

Councilman Scotford introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

of Morningside Court, Subdivision No. 1, upon which has been assessed certain street assessments, and said assessments with interest and penalties accruing under the taxation ordinance Number 155 of the Town of San Anselmo have not been paid, and

WHEREAS, the Improvement Bond Act of 1915, as amended, provides that the City Council may order the same to be collected by suit brought in the Superior Court to foreclose the lien thereof,

IT IS NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney be, and is hereby directed to institute the necessary legal proceedings to collect said delinquent assessments, with interest, penalties and costs, as by statute provided."

Motion was seconded by Councilman Wright and carried by the following vote:

A communication signed James H. Mitchell, representing various cities concerning the 1915 Bond Act litigation was read and played on file.

Upon motion of Councilman Wright, the Clerk was directed to notify the P.G. & E. CO. that Council authorizes said Company to proceed with its tree trimming program, to be done under the supervision of the Davey Tree Surgery Co. Ltd., providing they will supervise all of such work performed by the P.G. & E. Co. in the Town of San Anselmo.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, Dec. 12th, 1933, at 8 o'clock P.M.
