Upon motion of Councilman Jordan, the plan submitted by Geo. W. Manley, Engineer, relating to contemplated improvements in the proposed recreation center, to be handled as a C.W.A. project, was approved by the Council and the Mayor was authorized to sign any documents pertaining thereto.

MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 27TH, 1934.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Tuesday, February 27th, 1934, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Linch and Fusselman.  
Absent: Councilman Jordan.  
Mayor Fusselman presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of February 20th were approved as read.

ORDINANCE NO. 225 SPECIAL ELECTION - \$25,000 BOND ISSUE):

An Ordinance "calling for an election to be held in the Town of San Anselmo, Marin Co., State of California, to submit to the qualified voters thereof the propositions of incurring a bonded indebtedness by said Town for the purpose of paying the cost of certain improvements therein", was presented for final reading, was read, passed and adopted by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Linch and Fusselman.  
Noes: None.  
Absent: Councilman Jordan.

The Ordinance was then signed by the Mayor and numbered 225.

Councilman Dempsey introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that a General Municipal Election be held in said Town of San Anselmo, on Monday, the 9th day of April, 1934, for the purpose of electing the following officers: Three (3) Councilmen for the full term.

There will be three Voting Precincts for the purpose of holding said election, which Precincts shall be a consolidation of the regular election precincts for holding State and County elections, and shall be as follows:

Consolidated Voting Precinct "A", comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4, and the polling place thereof shall be at the Yolansdale School House.

Consolidated Voting Precinct "B", comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 5, 6 and 7, and the polling place thereof shall be Schrader's Garage on Saunders Avenue at Yolanda Station.

Consolidated Voting Precinct "C", comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 11, and the polling place thereof shall be the Town Hall.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the election officers for said election shall receive as compensation for their services the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) each, and that they shall be as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the said day of election the polls shall be open between the hours of 6:30 o'clock A. M. and 8 o'clock P.M. and the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to cause notice of said election to be published as required by law."

Resolution was seconded by Councilman Scotford and carried by the following vote:

- Ayes: Councilmen Dempsey, Scotford, Linch and Fusselman.
- Noes: None.
- Absent: Councilman Jordan.

The Clerk was instructed to write to Mr. W. F. Thomas for permission to use the Yolansdale School House as a voting place for both the special and regular municipal elections.
