MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 15TH, 1936.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, September 15th, 1936, at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Franchini, Millard, Carroll, White and Linch.
Absent: None.
Mayor Linch presiding.

The minutes of the past several meetings were approved as read.

On motion of Councilman Carroll, seconded by Councilman White, and unanimously passing, a warrant in the sum of \$100. was drawn in favor of the Navy Day programe, such amount to be charged to "Advertising",.

The request from the Sanitary District that the Town meet half of the cost of the replacing of a faulty sewer pipe under the Barber Tract entrance bridge was referred to the Street Committee for recommendation.

On motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman White and unanimously passing, the Sohner Tree Service was authorized to carry out its contract trimming the trees and clearing the lines for the Pacific Gas & Electric Co. throughout the Town.

On motion of Councilman White, seconded by Councilman Millard and unanimously passing, the Purchasing Agent was authorized to make certain expenditures for the several departments, as set forth in his written request of even date.

The Annual Report of the Fire Department was read and placed on file. Similar action was taken on the Building Inspector's report for the month of August.

After some discussion, and upon recommendation of the Engineer, the Members of the Council agreed to meet with the owners of the Brookside Meadow Tract on Saturday, September 19th, at 3 P.M. for the purpose of viewing the new Subdivision and checking street widths, drainage, etc., preparatory to accepting the map on Tuesday, September 19th.

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, the salary of A. N. Thorpe was increased \$10. per month, such increase to take effect at once.

On motion of Councilman White, seconded by Councilman Millard and unanimously passing, George Davis was appointed relief man for both Police and Fire Departments, at a salary of \$125. per month. He will work full time in the Fire Department during the next month or six weeks, and

thereafter to alternate his time in both departments during his probationary appointment.

WARRANTS:

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman White, and unanimously passing, Warrants Nos. 2223 to 2286, incl., were ordered paid.

On motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman Millard, and unanimously passing, the Town Attorney was instructed to confer with the Engineer and Street Committee with the view to preparing an Ordinance governing new Subdivision Maps, outlining widths and types of streets therein, drainage problems, etc.

On motion of Councilman Carroll, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, the Engineer was authorized to construct concrete footings and certain other repairs to the foot bridge opposite the Town Hall, such work not to exceed \$495.00.

The Council deferred action on the completion of Sir Francis Drake improvement project until the Spring of 1937.

On motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, the Clerk was instructed to notify the Railroad Company of the "Town Clean-up Programe" and to ask their full co-operation in cleaning up the Creek opposite the Station between the north foot bridge and the trestle south of the depot.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, September 22nd, 1936, at 8 o'clock P.M.
