

MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 10TH 1936.

A regular meeting of the City Council was held on Tuesday, November 10th, 1936, at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Franchini, Millard, Carroll, White and Linch.
Absent: None.
Mayor Linch presiding.

The minutes of the meeting of October 13th were approved as read. On motion of Councilman White, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, the Purchasing Agent was authorized to make such expenditures as were set forth in his written request of even date.

The petition of Mrs. J. Gandolfo for the removal of a light pole and cutting off a corner of the town parking lot was referred to the Street Committee for consideration.

A communication from the City Health Officer concerning the burying and burning of garbage was received and placed on file. Similar action was taken on his letter in reference to sewerage drainage into the creek opposite the Railroad Depot.

The Clerk was instructed to advise the City Health Officer that the Council is now drafting a plumbing ordinance which they propose to adopt in the very near future.

A letter of thanks from the Chairman of the "Navy Day" Celebration Board was received and placed on file.

Similar action was taken on the report of the Building Inspector for the month of October.

WARRANTS: On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman White, and unanimously passing, Warrants Nos. 2353 to 2416, incl. were ordered paid.

RESOLUTION NO. 116: (Special Assessments - Rosenthal Tract):

Councilman Carroll introduced Resolution No. 116 and moved its adoption. Motion to adopt said resolution was seconded by Councilman Millard and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Franchini, Millard, Carroll, White and Linch.
Noes: None.

On motion of Councilman Carroll, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, the Assessor was authorized to cancel the assessments levied against several parcels of land in the Barber Tract, the titles to which are now vested in the Veteran's Welfare Board.

On recommendation of the Engineer and on motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman Millard, and unanimously passing, the

Superintendent of Streets was instructed to repair the Arroyo Ave. Bridge at a cost not in excess of \$50.00. W 7448

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman White, Dr. A. J. Schwarz was appointed Health Officer to fulfill the vacancy created through the resignation of Dr. Hensler. Motion was seconded by Councilman White and carried unanimously.

"An Ordinance prohibiting drunkenness in Public places" was presented for first reading and was read.

ORDINANCE NO. 240:

"An Ordinance amending Garbage Ordinance No. 162, by amending Sections one and two and repealing Section 5 thereof, etc." was presented for first reading and was read.

Tentative plans for the remodeling of the Tamalpais Theatre were presented to the Council for approval.
