MINUTES OF MAY 19TH, 1937.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council of the Town of San Anselmo was held on Wednesday, May 19th, 1937, at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Carroll, White and Linch.

Absent: Councilmen Franchini and Millard.

Mayor Linch presided.

The reading of the minutes of the past several meetings was dispensed with.

The communication of Mrs. Nipper in reference to a dangerous corner at Bolinas Ave. and Waverly Road was referred to the Street Committee for consideration.

RESOLUTION NO. 128 - (CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS):

On motion of Councilman Linch, Resolution No. 128, approving and adopting rules and regulations for the administration of the Civil Service System of said Town was passed and adopted by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Carroll, White and Linch.

Noes: None.

Absent: Councilmen Franchini and Millard.

On motion of Councilman White, the Chief of Police was authorized to accept the bid of the Coombs Auto Co. of \$4.50 per month, per car, for servicing the several police cars recently purchased for that department.

Motion was seconded by Councilman Carroll and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Carroll, White and Linch.

Noes: None.

Absent: Councilmen Franchini and Millard.

On motion of Councilman Carroll permission was granted the local post of the American Legion to fly a banner over Sir Francis Drake Blvd., at the intersection of San Francisco Blvd. for the period of one month or more, it being understood that such work be carried on under the direction of the Superintendent of Streets.

ORDINANCE NO. 245 - COLLECTION OF TAXES, ETC.):

On motion of Councilman White, "An Ordinance providing for the assessment, levy and collection of taxes, etc." was presented for final reading and was passed and adopted by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Carroll, White and Linch,

Noes: None.

Absent: Councilmen Franchini and Millard.

Thereafter, the Ordinance was signed by the Mayor and numbered 245.

ORDINANCE NO. 246: (SALE OF COMMODITIES BY WEIGHT):

On motion of Councilman White, "An Ordinance requiring the sale of certain commodities by weight" was presented for final reading and was passed and adopted by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Carroll, White and Linch.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilmen Franchini and Millard.

Thereafter, the Ordinance was signed by the Mayor and numbered 246.

On motion of Councilman Carroll, the Engineer was instructed to establish the proper grade for the construction of the continuation of Hillcrest Ave. at no expense to the Town.

On motion of Councilman White, the Mayor was authorized to affix his signature to the contract between the Town and F. J. Main, for the construction of tennis courts. Motion was seconded by Councilman Carroll and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Carroll, White and Linch.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilmen Franchini and Millard.

On motion duly made and carried, the Superintendent of Streets was authorized to remove the light standards from the Main Street bridge.

On motion of Councilman Linch, Warrant No. ²⁸²⁷~~2227~~, in the amount of \$200. was ordered drawn in favor of Robt. W. Harrison, for special services in connection with recent foreclosure proceedings for nonpayment of street assessments, and Councilman Carroll was appointed member of the Finance Committee pro tem. Motion was seconded by Councilman Carroll and carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Councilmen Carroll, White and Linch.
Noes: None.
Absent: Councilmen Franchini and Millard.

On motion of Councilman White, the Mayor was authorized to affix his signature to the renewal of the lease purchase contract for police cars handled by the American Trust Company.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, June 8th, 1937 at 8 o'clock P.M.
