

MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 1, 1938.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, November 1, 1938 at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen White, Franchini, Millard, Carroll and Linch.
Absent: None.
Mayor Linch presiding.

The reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

RESOLUTION NO. 164: (Declaring an old abandoned bldg. a nuisance):

On motion of Councilman White, seconded by Councilman Millard, Resolution No. 164, declaring an old abandoned building a nuisance was unanimously passed and adopted.

On motion of Councilman White, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, the Mayor was authorized to make an adjustment on the damaged police car, ordering its repair or replacement, if necessary.

NEW FIRE EQUIPMENT: On motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, the recommendation of the Fire Chief concerning the new fire truck ^{was accepted and} the Purchasing Agent was authorized to enter into a lease contract with the Bank of America for the rental of a Seagrave Fire Engine, equipped with a 750 gallon pumper.

ORDINANCE NO. 253: (GARBAGE DISPOSAL): An Ordinance providing for the collection and disposal of garbage was presented for third reading, and on motion of Councilman White, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, the reading of same was by title only.

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman Franchini, the Ordinance was unanimously passed and adopted. Thereafter, it was signed by the Mayor and numbered 253.

A communication was read from the Local Post of the American Legion concerning the replanting of a Christmas tree in the Municipal grounds and placed on file.

Attorney Fyfe, representing D. Prola, made application for a renewal of the garbage removal contract, submitting a bid of \$125. per month to the Town for such service, accompanied by a check in said amount, covering payment for first month's franchise fee under renewed contract.

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, the contract for the removal of garbage from the Town was awarded to D. Prola for a period of ten years.

On motion of Councilman Carroll, seconded by Councilman Millard, and unanimously passing, the Mayor was authorized to enter into a contract

between Mr. Prola and the Town, and affix his signature to all papers in connection therewith.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to Tuesday, November 8th, 1938, at 8 o'clock P.M.

The petition received from the Veteran's Welfare Department for cancellation of taxes levied against several parcels of land, title to which is vested in said Department, was read and referred to the City Attorney for approval.
