MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 29TH 1940.

A special meeting was held on February 29th 1940 at 8 o'clock

P.M. Present: Councilmen Millard, Carroll and Linch.
Absent: Councilmen White and Franchini. Mayor Linch presiding.

RESOLUTION NO. 218: (MUNICIPAL ELECTION - 1940):

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman Carroll, the following Resolution was unanimously passed and adopted:

"RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that a General Municipal Election will be held in said Town of San Anselmo on Tuesday, the 9th day of April, 1940, for the purpose of electing the following officers:

1. Two Councilmen for the full term of four years.
2. City Clerk for the full term of four years.
3. City Treasurer for the full term of four years.

There will be four Voting Precincts for the purpose of holding said election, which precincts shall be consolidations of the regular election precincts for holding State and County elections, and shall be as follows:

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "A", comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 216, 217, 218 and 230, and the polling place thereof shall be FALK'S GARAGE on Butterfield Road at Sir Francis Drake Blvd.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "B", comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 219, 220, 221 and 228, and the polling place thereof shall be RAPHAEL'S GARAGE at 1218 San Anselmo Ave. near Yolanda Station.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "C", comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 222, 223, 224, 225 and 229, and the polling place thereof shall be the WOMEN'S IMPROVEMENT CLUB BUILDING on Tunstead Avenue.

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "D", comprising State and County Precincts Nos. 226 and 227, and the polling place thereof shall be BOB VAN WAAY'S MAIN STREET GARAGE at 204 Sir Francis Drake Blvd. across from the Main Depot.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Election Officers for said election shall receive as compensation for their services the sum of Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$7.50) each, and they shall be as follows:
