MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 11th, 1941.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Council was held on September 11th, 1941, at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Councilmen Franchini, Millard, Carroll and Linch.
Absent: Councilman White.
Mayor Linch presiding.

The reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

The petition of H. Hulshof and P.M. Bambino of 226 and 332 Floribel Ave., respectively, for relief from storm drain waters purportedly caused by the installation of a culvert to divert water from Redwood Road was read and filed. Both petitioners were present and addressed Council in this connection. After discussing the matter, it was agreed that Councilman Carroll and the Superintendent of Streets would view the location and recommend such changes as they may deem necessary.

A communication was received from M. V. Post 284, American Legion, requesting that Council join the several organizations in protesting to the California State Highway Commission the present hazard to motorists at both Alto and Greenbrae intersections with 101 Highway.

On motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, the Clerk was instructed to petition the State Highway Commission to construct some sort of safeguard for the traveling public at both of said intersections.

RESOLUTION NO. 298 - (SALE OF LOT 7 - H.F. MANN'S SUB - BUSH TRACT):

On motion of Councilman Carroll, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, Resolution No. 298, setting the fair market value of Lot 7, as per Map of H. F. Mann's Resub. of Lots 120 to 128, inclusive, Amended Map of the Bush Tract, at \$25.00, and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute a deed conveying said Lot to Claude A. and Margaret Ivers, was adopted. The Tax Collector was authorized to cancel all taxes and assessments of record appearing as a lien against said parcel of land.

RESOLUTION NO. 299 -(SALE OF LOT 53, SHORT RANCH):

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, Resolution No. 299, setting the fair market value of Lot 53, as per Map of the short Ranch, Sub. 1 at \$ ^{100⁰⁰} and authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute a deed conveying said Lot to Otho and Ora M. Von Waddell, was adopted. The Tax Collector was authorized to cancel all taxes and assessments of record appearing as a lien against said parcel of land.

TAX ROLL CHANGES:

On motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, Council authorized certain changes in the following assessments appearing on the 1940-41 Tax Roll:- Assessment Nos. 29-63-78-186-757-3045-3074-3096-3098 and 3105, as set forth in a report of the Tax Collector, dated August 20th, 1941 and now on file in the office of the Clerk.

On motion of Councilman Franchini, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and unanimously passing, Council authorized the Clerk to furnish the Auditor of the Town books and accounts, in a letter dated September 11th, 1941, a summary of sales and agreements of real property owned by the Town which have been entered into since last year's audit, a copy of which is on file in the Clerk's office.

Reports of the Building and Plumbing Inspectors for the month of August, 1941, were received and placed on file.

WARRANTS:

On motion of Councilman Millard, Warrants Nos. 6718 to 6760, inclusive, were ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Franchini and carried by the following vote:

On motion of Councilman Millard, seconded by Councilman Franchini, and unanimously passing, the following employees of the Police, Fire and Street Departments were granted a \$5.00 per month increase in their salaries, effective as of July 1st, 1941.
